'Essential care' includes all the core services you need for a funeral, while 'extras' covers add-ons like a celebrant, catering, flowers and design touches. Choosing burial or cremation will also influence the final cost. We aim for complete transparency so you can make informed decisions that honour your loved one and suit your budget.

Introduction of Our Fees

Care of Your Loved One

\$970

Your loved one will be transferred into our care by at least two dedicated staff members, ensuring the highest level of respect at all times. They will be cared for in our accredited mortuary facilities by our experienced and highly trained mortuary staff.

Professional Fee

\$1,930

24/7 phone support to notify us when a loved one has passed. Compassionate guidance from our experienced team, including a dedicated meeting with one of our Funeral Arrangers. Our administration staff will liaise with nursing homes, doctors, Births, Deaths & Marriages managing all required legal documentation. This fee also contributes to the ongoing operational costs of our business.

Funeral Service Fee

\$2,900

Your Funeral Arranger will coordinate all aspects of the service, including communication with third parties such as florists, celebrants, newspapers, and catering providers. This fee also includes the support of our wider team, with staff attending and overseeing the service, including one of our trained audio-visual specialists and covers state-of-the-art facilities.
